CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

Entries are invited for the 8th WNAA Summer Open Exhibition from members of the WNAA. Selectors this year are Neil Leggett, Sally Hale and Martin Skipper. The subject matter of submitted works is at the free choice of entrants.

ELIGIBILITY

All types of artworks, including textiles, drawings, paintings, prints, photographic work. Works on paper should be mounted, framed and glazed to exhibition standard. 2D wall hanging work must be fitted with **mirror plates**. Wall hanging textiles should have appropriate means of hanging fitted. **Wall hanging work should not be wider than 44 ins. overall width.**

We also encourage **3D works – sculpture, ceramics, conceptual pieces and installations**. 3-dimensional works must be provided with a secure means of display provided by the artist to ensure safety and to avoid theft or damage. If your work is on a large scale, has unusual display requirements or is a proposed installation please supply details on a separate sheet and return with the entry form.

Work will be exhibited in **St. Nicholas Chapel**. The **Schumann Cabinet** will be featured – an opportunity to show small works for sale or simply for display. Artists are also encouraged to offer for sale **greetings cards or postcards** of their work in addition to their original artworks. Please make sure these are priced individually.

SALE OF WORK

All works sold will be subject to a commission fee of 20% (this includes prints and cards). **The price stated on the form below should be the selling price including commission.** **If you do not wish your work to be for sale, please mark it NFS on the rear label.**

AWARDS

In memory of our late friend and inaugural Chairman of the WNAA, Syd Davison, an award will be made for the **best in show**. This award will be the sixth Syd Davison Memorial Award. There will also be the **People's Choice Award** as voted by the Public. The prize is £50 from WNAA.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Maximum of 4 works per artist.
- Works should ideally be recent, completed since August 2008. Older work may only be submitted if it has not been previously exhibited.
- Enclose hanging fee of £15 per artist (whether you enter 1 or 4 pieces the fee is only £15). Cheque payable to the **West Norfolk Artists Association** (will be returned if unselected).
- Forms to be returned by **Monday 8th June 2009**. Acknowledgement of receipt will be sent by post or email.
- Each piece must be labelled **on the reverse** with title of work, media, price (or NFS) and your contact details.
- Artists must be prepared to **invigilate a maximum of two 3 hour sessions** in St Nicholas. This condition can only be waived by special arrangement with the exhibition organisers.

DELIVERY / SELECTION SCHEDULE

- **Delivery to St. Nicholas Chapel**, St. Anne's Street, King's Lynn, Norfolk on **Wednesday 15th July 10 am – 1 pm**. Any packing / bubble wrap etc. to be taken home.
- Selection takes place on **Wednesday 15th/Thursday 16th July**.
- Collection of unselected work on **Friday 17th July 1 – 4 p.m.**
- **Collection of work exhibited** at St. Nicholas Chapel on **Saturday 1st August between 3 – 4 pm.**
